03 · HOW WE REVIEW

A documented review methodology

Every Pondero review follows a public methodology so readers, and the brands we cover, know exactly what was tested, how, and on what hardware or tier. Methodology is the difference between an opinion and a recommendation worth citing.

HANDS-ON USAGE	Minimum 72 hours of real-work usage on the product before any verdict is published. No "first impressions" reviews; no demos-as-reviews.
DOCUMENTED SCENARIOS	Each review lists the specific test scenarios run, hardware/cloud tier used, and outcome per scenario. Reproducibility is the bar.
VERDICT STRUCTURE	Every review ends in a clear recommendation: who should use this, who should not, and what the alternative is for the bordering use case.
FTC DISCLOSURE	Affiliate relationships are disclosed on every monetized page. The disclosure is in the article body, not buried in a footer.
NO-PAY-FOR-VERDICT	Brands cannot buy a higher rating, change a published verdict, or block a critical review. Sponsored content is labeled and editorially separate.
UPDATE CADENCE	Major reviews are revisited within 90 days of significant product releases. Last-tested date is shown on every review page.
EDITORIAL INTEGRITY	Articles are written by named experts, edited against a published style standard, and pass a multi-point editorial gate (factual accuracy, source citations, disclosure check) before publication.

Four sections, multiple formats

Pondero organizes coverage around four sections where AI is changing professional workflows, plus a growing library of utility pages that help readers find and compare what they need. All formats share the same methodology, disclosure standard, and quality bar.

05 · AUDIENCE & DISTRIBUTION

Where readers find Pondero

Pondero reaches buyers through three reinforcing channels: organic search and AI overviews on the site itself, a weekly newsletter on Buttondown, and a presence on the social platforms where technical readers actually spend time. Every channel routes back to the same hands-on, named-byline editorial.

● NEWSLETTER

Buttondown · weekly

Pondero's newsletter ships from Buttondown. Issue 001 went out 2026-05-12 to the founding subscriber list. Format is short: one verdict, one tool to try this week, one thing to skip. Subscribe at pondero.ai (footer) or via the homepage capture.

● SOCIAL DISTRIBUTION

Bluesky, X, LinkedIn

A Bluesky autoposter is live and has backfilled 85 articles with rate-limited posting; new pieces post on publish. X and LinkedIn are operated as active editorial channels with founder bylines, not automated dumps. No TikTok or Instagram presence by design.

- **Search-first.** The /search/ page indexes 138 pages via Pagefind. The site is built for both classical search rankings and AI-overview citation.

- **Reader intent.** Pages are written for buyers comparing named products, not for casual scrollers. Time-on-page and scroll-depth reflect evaluation behavior, not entertainment.

- **LLM-cited.** Editorial structure (clear verdicts, named methodology, dated tests) is the format AI overviews and chat assistants prefer to cite.

- **Owned channels.** Newsletter, RSS, and direct site traffic are the load-bearing channels. Social is a referral and credibility layer, not the primary funnel.

06 · WHY BRANDS PARTNER WITH PONDERO

Intent-aligned readers. Authority by design.

Pondero's readers arrive with explicit purchase intent, evaluating an AI tool against alternatives, and they trust named experts more than ranked listicles. Affiliate partners benefit from this trust signal, alignment, and the long tail of LLM-cited recommendations.

- **Intent-aligned audience.** Readers land on a comparison page because they are deciding between named products. Conversion isn't browsing, it's resolution.

- **Named-expert authority.** Reviews carry verifiable bylines with real professional credentials. Trust is built into the byline, not the marketing.

- **Generative search citation.** Editorial structure is built for AI overviews and LLM citations, the discovery channel for the next 5 years of buying.

- **Long-form, evergreen.** Reviews and comparisons are 2,000 to 4,000 words, refreshed on a documented cadence. Affiliate value compounds, not decays.

- **FTC-compliant by default.** Disclosure is part of every monetized page. Brand legal teams sign off without negotiation.

- **Brand-safe tone.** Editorial voice is direct and operational, not sensational. Reviews can be quoted in case studies and sales decks without re-editing.

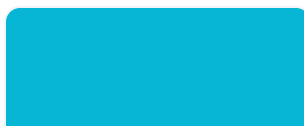
